modality. She has worked with Lisa Najavits, who developed the Seeking Safety program, and Treatment Innovations since 2011. Although she counsels children, adolescents and adults, she has spent the majority of her career working with adolescents. Her specialties are grief, trauma and addiction. After volunteering in juvenile detention centers for many years, starting in 1996, Summer went to graduate school to help address some of the underlying issues that contribute to youth entering the juvenile justice system. She completed her master's degree in counseling with a focus on children and adolescents and has specialized training in trauma-informed care. She has worked in nonprofit, group home, juvenile justice, residential and outpatient settings. After being trained by Lisa in Seeking Safety, Summer implemented Seeking Safety groups for adolescent boys and girls in a residential treatment program. Currently Lisa and Summer are working on an adolescent version of Seeking Safety.
